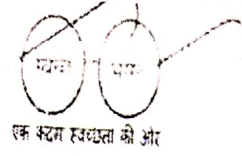



1. Land area and build-up area for running courses in combination shall be as under:
- i. The institutions shall possess 2500sq mts (two thousand five hundred square meters) of exclusive well demarcated land for the initial intake of fifty students out of which 1500 sq mts (one thousand five hundred square meters) shall be the built up area and the remaining sq mts (one thousand square meters) shall be reserved for the use of the institution for its purposes of lawns, playgrounds, etc. For an additional intake of fifty students, the institutions shall possess additional 500 sqm (five hundred square meters) in addition to the existing land. For an additional intake of up to three hundred, it shall possess land of 3500 sqm (Three thousand five hundred square meters). For the institutions established prior to this Regulation, for an additional intake of one hundred students, build up area is to be increased by 500 sqm (five hundred square meters) and the requirement of additional land may not apply to them.
 - ii. Build up area for running other teacher education programmes in combination with B Ed programme shall be as under.

2. If the college is running some other course(s) in addition to B.Ed. course in the same building, the Inspection Committee should exclude the facilities required and earmarked for other courses, while allowing the funds for the B.Ed. course. These facilities include: a) Laboratory, b) Library, c) Multipurpose Hall, Library and Laboratory (with proportionate addition of books and equipment) and instructional space can be shared by the students of all the courses provided no inconvenience is caused to the students.
3. Full credit to faculty will be given to the institutions only if the teacher was on rolls of the institution at least four months prior to the date of inspection. 75% credit will be given if teacher is appointed three months prior to the date of inspection, 50% credit if the teacher is appointed two months prior to the date of inspection and 25% credit will be given if teacher is appointed one month prior to the date of inspection.
4. The score for the faculty staff shall only be awarded if appointment letter issued to them and they have joined the institute.
5. Salary to teaching and non-teaching staff should to given through cheque/bank only.
6. The Inspection Committee will see sufficient proof of salary, salary paid through cheque/bank, deduction of P.F. and Income Tax deducted at source.
7. The Inspection Committee will see a list of available working teaching faculty including Principal and non-teaching staff in the prescribed proforma as:
